SENIOR SEMESTER EXAM NOTES

- 1. Senior exams will be on May 20 & 21. We will have a regular bell schedule on those days.**
- 2. Thursday, May 20th will be designated for exams in 2nd, 4th, 6th, & 8th periods.**
- 3. Friday, May 21st will be designated for exams in 1st, 3rd, 5th, & 7th periods.**
- 4. Stick to that schedule unless you will need both days to administer your exam. In that case, please feel free to utilize both days.**
- 5. Seniors not on the Senior Trip will take exams on Monday, May 24th.**
- 6. Seniors will have a "Check Out Card" for you to sign. Do not sign until you have calculated their final average. These must be completed and turned in by 3:35 on Friday, May 21st...Seniors taking exams on Monday, May 24th will turn their cards in by 3:35 on Monday.**

Exemption Notes:

- You must have a combined average in all classes of at least 85% with no individual class average below 75%.
- You must have **NO** major discipline issues (this semester) that result in either ISS or DAEP.
- If you miss more than 3 days in any one class, including tutorials, during the spring semester, you lose all exemptions.
- If you have any absence due to a doctor's appointment (partial day) this semester, you must submit your doctor's note within 3 days of your partial day medical absence. No notes will be accepted in May!
- Partial day medical means you attended school part of the day before or after your doctor's appointment, and you brought a doctor's note within 3 days of the absence.
- If you have questions, please come to the office for clarifications.
- The attendance committee will meet to verify absences and averages for exemptions. Do not ask your teachers to tell you if you are exempt.
- Any absence after May 14th may result in a loss of exam exemption.

ABSENCE CODES

- 1 – Excused Absence
- 3 – Unexcused Absence
- 9 – Full day Medical
- 5 – Partial Day Medical

Only partial day medical with doctor's notes do not count toward exemptions.

School-related absences (field trips, extra-curricular, etc.) and higher education (college visits) do not count toward exemptions.
